1. (A) CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:



In science and Technology Education, models on reproductive systems, series and parallel circuits, air pollution, water purification plants were innovatively executed by the students.


In Economics Education, students made models on the topics factors of production, demand and supply, Circular flow of income in two sector economy.

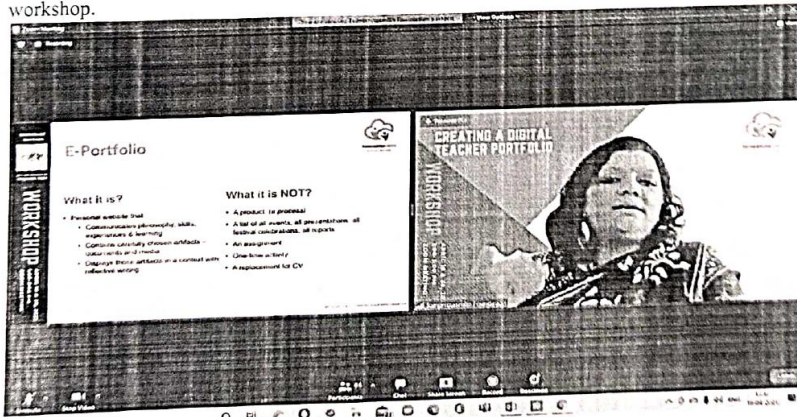

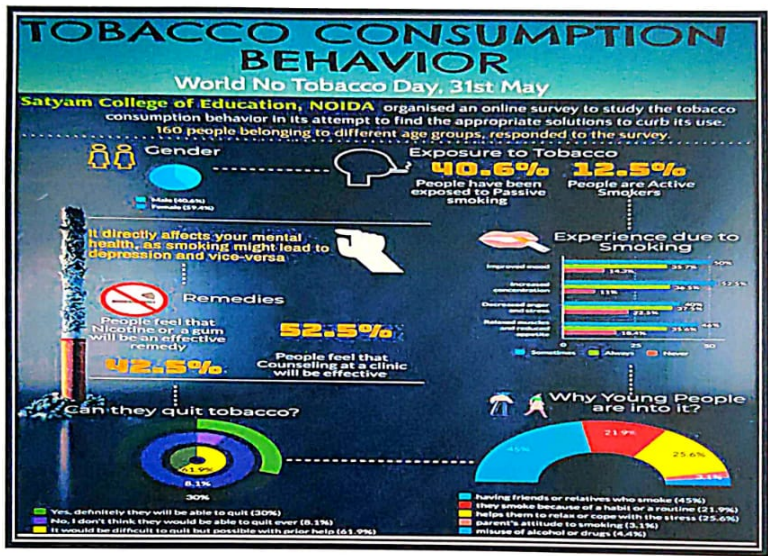
This study helped us understand that around 12.5% of people are active smokers whereas about 40.6% of the people are exposed to passive smoking which is equally harmful. About 45% of young people expressed that using tobacco helps them improve their mood and concentration and they started using it under the influence of their family and relatives. Most of the people (52.5%) feel that they can quit smoking and clinical counseling will be an effective remedy to curb its use.
